There are inherent risks in using and working around workplace equipment. Accidents may often be caused from the improper use of hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors. Warehouse tools, like skids, pallets, strapping and cutting tools, have to be utilized cautiously during packing, unpacking and loading.
