Forklift Training Guidelines

It is essential that all workplaces using forklifts have the checklist below or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to any question indicates a procedural weakness which may lead to injury, damage to equipment or accident.

- 1) Is the operating area of the forklift separate from the traffic of pedestrians?
- 2) Is access by pedestrians to forklift areas restricted by a barrier?
- 3) The walkways for pedestrians are well-marked?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs clearly visible?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for operators and pedestrians?
- 6) Changes or alterations to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to staff?
- 7) The lift truck tires being used are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Lift truck seatbelt is being utilized?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is an annual forklift certification and inspection carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift right for the tasks?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Do all operators know how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various uses and attachments?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the lift truck working properly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted properly on the forklift?
- 19) Do the operators of the lift truck have certifications to utilize the equipment?
- 20) Are warning signs and speed limits being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all types of forklifts being operated?
- 22) Forklift operators know their duties to report the damage to the machine and other forklift accidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed daily?
